## RESIDENCE

All individuals, who can show documentation, shall be residents of the Citizen Potawatomi Nation WIC Program Service Area, (Cleveland, Payne, Lincoln, Logan, Pottawatomie, Seminole and Oklahoma counties), members of the population served by the Citizen Potawatomi Nation, or receiving health care at the tribal health or IHS clinics in Wewoka, Shawnee, McLoud, or Oklahoma City area. This means if a person is a member of an Indian tribal recognized by the Federal Government thus eligible for services and resides outside the service area but uses the facilities on regular basis and will use the Citizen Potawatomi Nation WIC Program authorized vendors, then that person may participate.

## **INCOME ELIGIBILITY**

All individuals, who can show documentation, will be designated as income eligible in accordance with the National School Lunch Reduce Price Meal income guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Agriculture each year. All applicants who can show documentation that they are either recipients of food stamps under the Food Stamp Act of 1977 or recipients of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, (TANF), established under part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act shall be accepted as income eligible for the WIC Program. A person who documents that he/she is a member of a family that contains a TANF recipient or that contains a pregnant woman who received Medicaid shall be determined to be adjunctively income eligible for WIC.
